
Our mill started with an American ideal: make something not just better, but the best; a beautiful product built to last a lifetime, using homegrown resources. Hardwood flooring, we believed, could be crafted with greater precision, even in the most rustic grades, while still maintaining long length. Since 1995, customers have relied on us for excellence in milling, length, moisture control, and consistency in grading. We start with beautiful, well-managed North American hardwoods. From the felling of the log, through sawing, planing, grading, and packaging, our wood flooring is created entirely here in the U.S. Count on us for wood flooring made in the proud tradition of craftsmen.

We Make the Grade

To us, the term "rustic" is **not** an excuse to include all defects and lots of short pieces. Our careful grading ensures the integrity of the floor will not be compromised. Whether we're making rustic or higher grade floors, we follow the same strict milling tolerances. Every bit of wood traveling through our mill is put to use: what doesn't become flooring is utilized in heating, drying, or making our Woodchucks Fire Logs.

Cut and Dried

We don't leave moisture levels to chance. The correct moisture content is especially critical in wide-width flooring. Our drying methods, developed especially for arid climates, work in tandem with the naturally dry climate at our facility. The moisture content of Muscanell wood flooring will be a low 5-7% when it leaves our mill in Colorado.



Get What You Pay For

At Muscanell Millworks, our accurate tally system means what you're charged for is what you get. As part of our neat packaging, we add spacers beneath every other bundle to allow better air circulation and aid in acclimation. Every bundle is stamped with grade and square footage, and embossed with the Muscanell name.

No Lip

We monitor our machines constantly to minimize
overwood and other milling mistakes. For years, we've
provided flooring that needs very little sanding because
our team continually checks tolerances throughout the milling process.

We Measure Up

When it comes to length, our planks are consistently a cut above the rest. In almost all our grades and species, even the most rustic, lengths run 1' to 10' with a 5' average (and even longer by special request). Our generous lengths lend a rich look of continuity to the finished floor.
